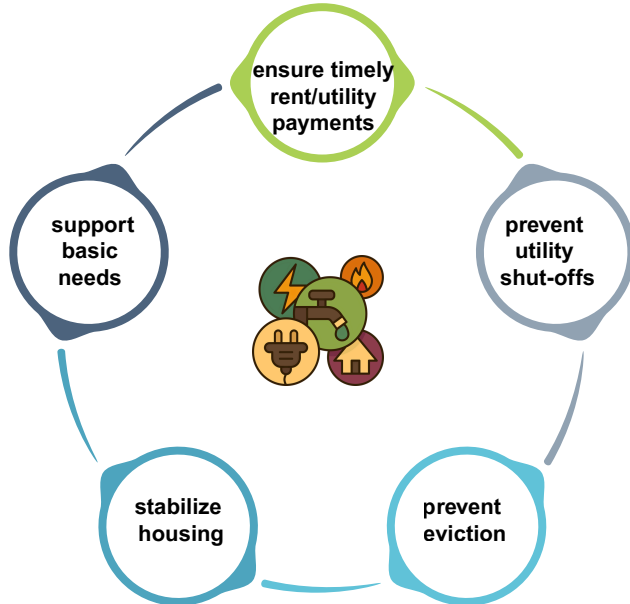
To provide support and services as a bridge to self-reliance for people in northern New Mexico.

What We Accomplished Together



When a disabled woman who had been unhoused for eight months finally received a call to move into low-income housing, we paid her security deposit so she could move into her new home.



When a man in a college work-study program received an eviction notice, we secured emergency rental assistance from a statewide partner to give him months of relief so he could stay in school.



When a woman raising four grandkids needed to fix her furnace, she fell behind on her electric bill and got a disconnect notice. We helped her catch up so she could start a payment plan.



When an elderly woman on a fixed income unexpectedly became a caregiver and fell behind on her expenses, we secured a grant to replace an old water heater so she could keep up with her utility bills.

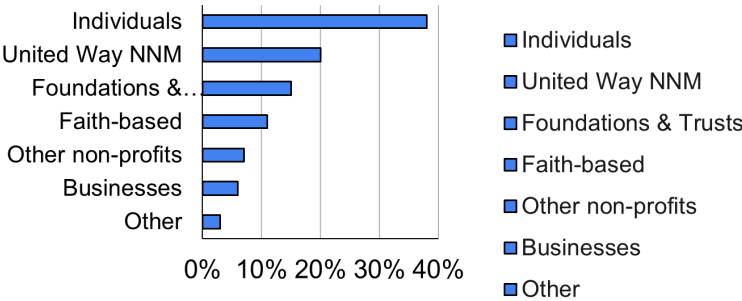

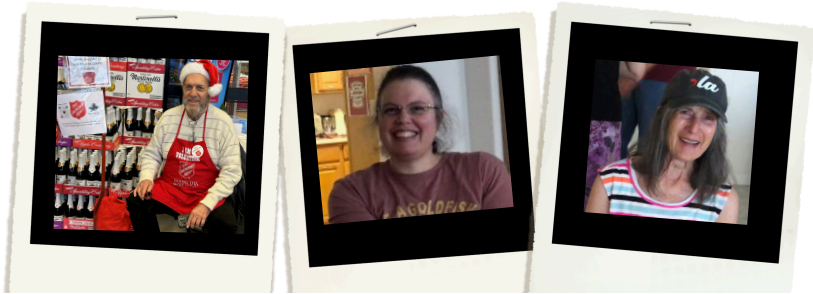
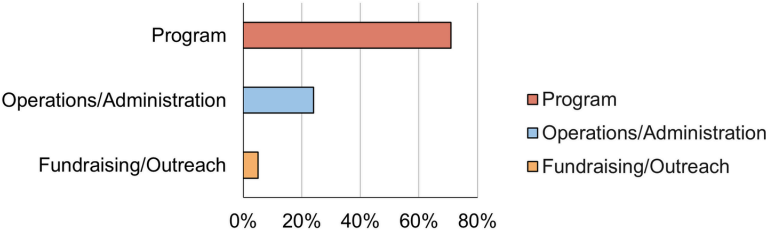
